Application Materials and Instructions

Applications may be submitted as early as January 1, 2009 but must be received no later than February 28, 2009

Eligibility Requirements:

In order to be eligible for the course, you must

- have or have had a college and/or graduate school GPA of 3.0 or higher (for applicants still in school who meet this requirement, admission will be contingent on review of the second semester transcript);
- forgo employment for the duration of the course, including nights and weekends (**preference will be given to applicants who demonstrate financial need**);
- attend all program sessions and complete all course assignments and practice exams; and
- take the LSAT at the first opportunity following the course (usually late September or early October).

Submission Requirements:

In order to be considered for participation in the course, you must submit the following materials by the deadline set forth below:

- the attached application form;
- evaluation forms from two faculty members (attached as an Appendix to the application);
- current copy of your college transcript and, if applicable, graduate school transcript (unofficial copies are acceptable);
- your parents' most recent Form 1040 as filed with the IRS, or if you are employed full-time, a copy of *your* most recently filed Form 1040; and
- a copy of your SAT score report or graduate school entrance exam score report (GMAT, GRE, etc.).

Deadline:

Application materials may be submitted as early as January 1, 2009 but must be received no later than February 28, 2009. All materials should be sent to Mr. Sandy Santana, Legal Outreach, 402 West 145th Street, New York, NY 10031 or ssantana@legaloutreach.org. You may also fax application materials to (212) 690-9989. Applicants will be notified by March 15, 2009. Approximately 15 students will be selected. Accepted applicants will be asked to provide, upon acceptance, a deposit of \$150, which will be refunded upon satisfactory completion of all course requirements.
