






Our Programs

Legal Outreach believes that in order to achieve diversity within any profession, early intervention in the lives of underrepresented groups is a necessity. The organization thus recruits high potential eighth graders from underserved communities and immerses them in a five-week **Summer Law Institute (SLI)** in partnership with six law schools. Upon completion, the SLI participants apply for admission to **College Bound**, Legal Outreach's four-year, intensive academic skill development and support program designed to prepare them for the rigors of college. Meeting after school, on Saturdays and during the summers, students spend over 2,300 additional hours beyond high school building and sharpening the skills needed for success.
