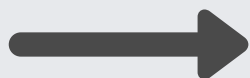
RAISING THE BAR OF STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

OUR PROGRAMS

To achieve diversity within any profession, early intervention in the lives of underrepresented groups is a necessity. Legal Outreach thus recruits high potential eighth graders from underserved communities and immerses them in a five-week **Summer Law Institute (SLI)** in partnership with six law schools. Upon completion, the SLI participants apply for admission to **College Bound**, Legal Outreach's four-year, intensive academic skill development and support program designed to prepare them for the rigors of college. Meeting after school, on Saturdays and during the summers, students spend over 2,300 hours building and sharpening the skills needed for college and professional success.

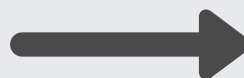

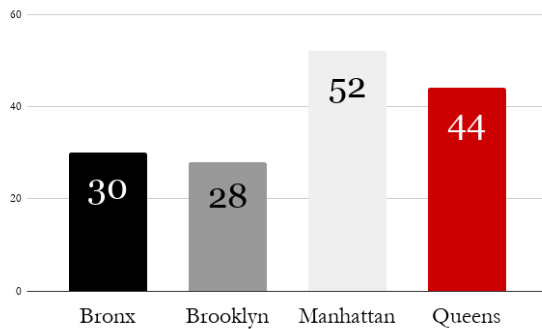

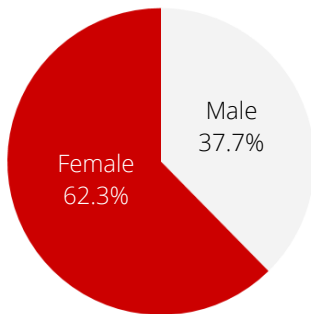
Schools Attended in each Borough

Classes 2013 - 2020



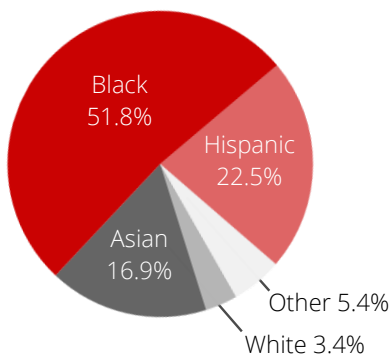
Gender

Classes 2013 - 2020



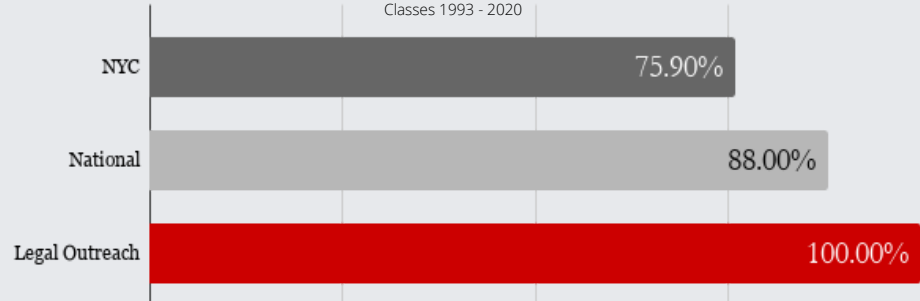
Ethnicity

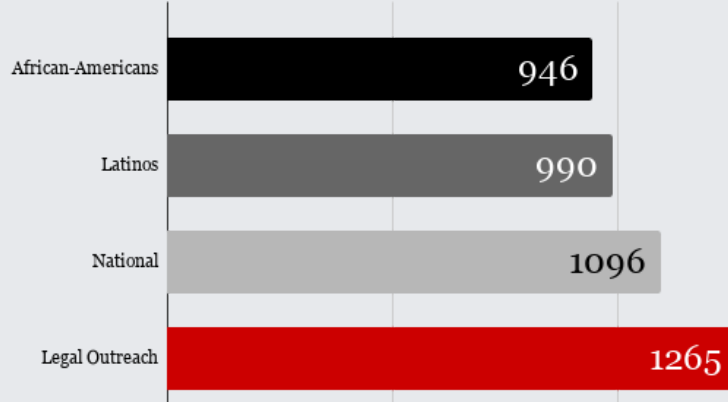
HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION RATES

Classes 1993 - 2020



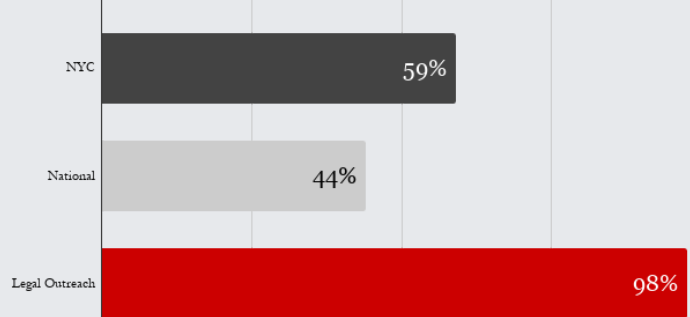
AVERAGE SAT SCORES

Classes 1993 - 2020



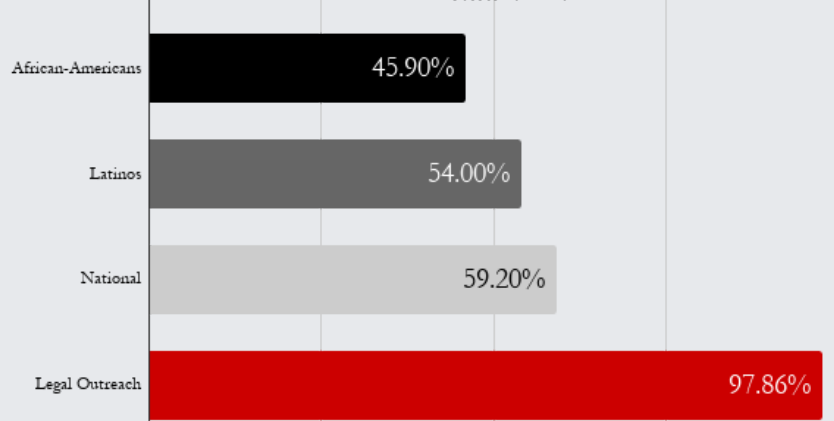
MATRICULATION RATE TO MOST & HIGHLY SELECTIVE COLLEGES
